

OCTOBER GALLERY EDUCATION ONLINE WORKSHOPS

Inspired by artists from around the world

October Gallery Education offers unique experiences for school students to create and learn about art in a real gallery space, working alongside artworks made by internationally renowned artists which are on display to sell. In these unprecedented times we are now offering interactive and online workshops as an exciting replacement for the workshops which would usually happen in the gallery.

The workshops are developed by artists alongside the Head of Education and reflect the October Gallery current exhibition themes. We will create videos both in the gallery setting as a tour and of actual demonstrations for art making ideas in the classroom. All the activities will be tailored to suit the needs, ages and abilities of the students you work with. The workshops will be inspired by the current exhibition but reflect our broad approach to art as a cross-curricular subject. The students will learn about the context in which the artist creates their work and then be set activities in which they will be challenged to make their own creative responses to these themes.

We will create a new workshop pack for each exhibition, but you can choose which one you would like to try in relation to subjects, projects and your own syllabus.









As part of each online workshop you will receive:

- Link to introductory video of the gallery and tour of the exhibition
- PDF (this can also be posted) with information for the teacher about the
 artist, questions and short written activities to engage the students in looking
 at the art and thinking about the context in which it was made. Including
 looking closely at techniques, materials used, influences, composition and
 wider historical/social/cultural context.
- Images of each individual artwork (again these can be sent in the post).
- Link to example videos made by OG Education team and tailored to each Key Stage.
- PDF with instructions for activities in the video with list of materials and resources for teachers.
- Zoom/Google Meet link have a live interactive chat with Head of Education to answer students' questions and chance for students to show off their work to someone external and reflect on what they have learnt.

We are also offering workshops in your school which can be a morning or afternoon or for the whole day, depending on how many classes you would like us to works with. We will adapt our workshops and teaching to adhere to government guidelines and the specific Covid-19 precautions operating in your school.
